Re: Transition of contributions and remittance reporting effective December 1, 2017

This memo is a follow-up to a communication in January announcing changes to the contributions and remittance reporting process for any employers remitting contributions under SAG-AFTRA collective bargaining agreements (CBAs).

Effective December 1, 2017, employers will be required to submit remittance reports and contributions to a central repository maintained by the SAG-AFTRA Health Plan (Plan). Upon receipt, the Plan will direct remittance records and contributions to the respective pension plans on behalf of employers in accordance with the CBAs. All payments and associated reports should be submitted to:

For remittances under the Commercials or Corporate/Educational & Non-Broadcast agreements that specify an allocation between the SAG-Producers Pension Plan and the AFTRA Retirement Fund, employers and their paying agents will be obligated to continue making such allocations and submit separate contributions remittances for allocation to the Plan.

Plan staff is working collaboratively with the AFTRA Retirement Fund to make this transition as seamless as possible for you.
